

NO. 16 THE LOCK UP

1. The Council shall continue to maintain the lock up house at present established in the town, or such other lock up house in lieu thereof, or in addition thereto, as it determines, and shall, as may be necessary, from time to time appoint a keeper thereof.
2. The keeper of the lock up shall:
 - a. keep the cells in such lock up comfortable and in a sanitary condition;
 - b. provide, at the expense of the town, meals for the prisoners in the lock up, and
 - c. assist the police officer when he arrives at the lock up with a prisoner.
3. The committee on police and licenses may, subject to the approval of the Council, from time to time make amend or repeal rules for regulations of the keeper of the lock up.
