FIRE PREVENTION BY-LAW

The Fire Prevention By-law of the Town of Trenton is hereby amended as follows:

- By repealing, in its entirety, Section 2. (1)
 - By repealing, in its entirety, Section 2. (2)
 - By repealing, in its entirety, Section 3.
 - By repealing, in its entirety, Section 4.
 - By repealing, in its entirety, Section 5.
 - By repealing, in its entirety, Section 7.
 - By inserting Section 2 (a) as stated below.
 - By inserting Section 2 (b) as stated below.
 - By re-numbering all remaining Sections accordingly.
-

1. This By-law may be cited as the “Fire Prevention By-law” for the Town of Trenton.
2. (a) No person shall burn the following within the Town of Trenton:
 - (i) rubbish;
 - (ii) garbage;
 - (iii) uncut grass;
 - (iv) brush;
 - (v) clippings (lawn or leaf);
 - (vi) leaves;
 - (vii) debris; and/or
 - (viii) other materials associated with lawn waste.

(b) No person shall make or burn a bonfire or other fire within the Town of Trenton.

(c) No person shall utilize a burning appliance unless it is CSA or ULC approved.
3. No person shall make, light, start or cause to be made, lit or started any fire on any land of which such person is neither occupant nor owners, nor shall such person fail to exercise reasonable care to prevent any fire made, lit or started from extending to lands not owned or occupied by such person.
4. No permit shall be required for a fire that is ignited in a licensed campground providing the fire is made in a suitable place and precautions are taken against the spreading of the fire.
5. Every person who contravenes this By-law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalty prescribed by or in the Summary Proceedings Act.
6. All Fire Prevention By-laws heretofore passed by the Town of Trenton are hereby repealed.
