Water System Service Area Policy

1. Purpose

1.1. The primary purpose of the Water System Service Area Policy is to provide clarity on the areas of the Town that are serviced by the water system and benefit from the provision of fire hydrant services. The service area defined in this policy will be subject to a fire protection levy, if imposed by Town By-law, as provided in Section 80(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S.N.S 1998, c.18).

2. Policy

2.1. Water System Service Area

- 2.1.1. The water system service area is designated as all of the area situate within the borders of the Town of Trenton except:
- 2.1.1.1. that area consisting of properties situate within the Town boundaries and fronting on Little Harbour Road;
 - 2.1.1.2. that area consisting of properties situate within the Town boundaries and fronting on that section of Park Road lying to the east of the entrance to Trenton Park;
 - 2.1.1.3. that area consisting of properties situate within the Town boundaries and fronting on Egypt Road;
- 2.1.2. Council may, with the required approval of the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board, expand or reduce the water system service area designated in this policy.
