## SNOW AND ICE CONTROL POLICY

### Scope

This policy will apply to snow and ice control within the Town of Trenton and is adopted under authority of Section 48(3) and 65(f) of the Municipal Government Act.

### Policy

The Public Works Department will endeavour to begin a snow and ice control operation as soon as accumulation warrants as determined by the Director of Public Works and/or the Chief of Police. The Town will endeavour to maintain high priority routes (listing below) in a passable condition throughout a storm event. The Town will endeavour to provide sufficient equipment to enable streets to be opened within 10 to 12 hours after a storm of 10 to 15 centimeters.
