FIRE DEPARTMENT HONORARIA POLICY

Scope

This policy will apply to the Officers and Members of the Fire Department of the Town of Trenton and is adopted under authority of Section 65(h) of the Municipal Government Act.

Policy

1. The Town shall pay the following schedule of honoraria and rates to the Trenton Fire Department:

(a)	Chief	\$1,500.00 per year
(b)	Deputy Chief	\$ 500.00 per year
(c)	Secretary	\$ 400.00 per year
(d)	Caretaker	\$ 400.00 per year
(d)	Captain	\$ 250.00 per year
(e)	Lieutenant	\$ 125.00 per year
(f)	Firefighters	\$ 9.32 per hour while fighting fires

2. Under Item 1. (f), effective November 1, 2003, the annual cost of living allowance for the hourly rate for firefighters while fighting fires is the Consumer Price Index at August of the current year or the average of the two Town of Trenton union contracts (namely, CUPE and PANS), whichever is higher.
