

**FEEDING OF WILD ANIMALS BY-LAW
NO. 2018-001**

TITLE: This By-law shall be known and cited as the Feeding of Wild Animals By-law for the Town of Trenton.

PART 1. DEFINITIONS

In this By-law, unless the context otherwise requires:

“Council” means the Town Council of the Town of Trenton.

“Designated Area” means that portion or portions of the Town designated by Council policy to which the provisions of this By-Law shall not apply.

“Public Place” means streets, sidewalks, public parks and trails, property owned by the Town and recreation facilities funded in whole or part by the Town.

“Town” means the Town of Trenton.

“Wild Animal” means any animal which is not domesticated.

PART 2 AUTHORITY

2.1 Pursuant to Subsection 174(f) of the *Municipal Government Act* (R.S. 1998, c.18) the Town has the authority to make by-laws respecting wild and domestic animals and activities in relation to them.

PART 3 PROHIBITION ON FEEDING

3.1 No person shall feed one or more wild animals in any place within the Town in such a manner or to such an extent that doing so causes or may cause an unreasonable interference with another person’s use and enjoyment of his or her property or of a Public Place.

PART 4 CONTRAVENTION OF BY-LAW

4.1 Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is punishable on summary conviction by a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 or to imprisonment of not more than 30 days in default of payment thereof.
