

NO. 28 LOITERING BY LAW

1. No person shall loiter on or around the entrance or steps of any church, place of worship, hall, public building, store, shop, or dwelling in the Town, nor in or near any of the streets or lanes of the Town, nor in any public place in the Town.

2. (1) No person shall enter a private dwelling or place of business without the permission of the owner or occupant, or remain therein after he has been requested to withdraw by the owner or occupant, his servant or agent, or any police officer.

(2) If a person is requested to withdraw from such premises by the owner or occupant, his servant or agent, or any police officer, and neglects or refuses to do so, he may be removed therefrom by a police officer.

3. Any person who violates any provision of Section 1 or 2, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$250.00 and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days.
