

NO. 23 BICYCLES

Regulations respecting Bicycles Pursuant
to Section 228 of the Motor Vehicle Act,
being chapter 6 of Acts of 1932 and
amendments thereto.

1. No bicycle owned by a resident of the Town of Trenton and in respect to which a permit and number plate has not yet been granted as provided in this regulation, shall be operated on any street of the Town of Trenton.
2. Such permit shall be granted by the Chief of Police, and shall permit operation of a bicycle specified therein, until the 31st day of December next succeeding.
3. The permit shall specify the owner of the bicycle and the size, make and serial number of the bicycle and the number of the permit.
4. The fee for such permit shall be twenty five cents.
5. Together with the permit there shall be granted to the applicant therefor a number plate with the number corresponding to that on the permit, marked thereon and such number plate shall be kept displayed in a conspicuous place on the rear frame of the bicycle.
6. Every person who:
 - a. operates on any street in the Town of Trenton a bicycle owned by a resident of the said Town in respect to which a permit has not been granted, or
 - b. operates on any street in the Town of Trenton a bicycle owned by a resident of the said Town to which a number plate is not attached as aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable for each such offence to a penalty not exceeding five dollars or in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding seven days.
