

Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre

Reopening Plan

October 2020



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Preamble

The Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre has created this document as a part of their reopening plan for public usage. During the creation of this plan the public health and wellbeing of individual was at the forefront ensuring that all users of the facility including staff be safe and enjoy their visit.

Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre believes that by creating this plan and having all users follow the strict rules enforced by both the Nova Scotia Government and the Town of Trenton, we will be able to reopen and have a successful winter season.

Practice/Game/ Rental

Entry

All entry for ice rink access will be through the main doors located at the front of the rink. Players will proceed immediately to the dressing rooms and spectators will proceed to the designated spectating areas.

Exit

All players will exit the dressing room, turn right, and exit the facility through the marked doors at the end of the hallway.

All spectators must exit out of the side doors only. Doors will be mark "EXIT".

Lobby Area

Main lobby area will be restricted to flow through traffic only. Spectators will not be permitted to wait or gather in this area.

Facility Access

Players

All players may enter the facility no earlier than 15 minutes before the start of their scheduled ice time. All players must exit the facility no later than 15 minutes after this ice time.

Spectators

All spectators may enter the facility no earlier than 5 minutes prior to the beginning of the scheduled ice time. All spectators must exit the facility immediately after the completion of their scheduled ice time. Spectators who are drivers for players will wait in the parking lot for the participant to exit the facility.

Practice- ONE spectator per player

Games- TWO spectators per player

No dryland training or warmups will be permitted inside the facility.

Masks

Players & Coaches

All players and coaches will be required to wear masks in the following areas of the rink.

Entering the facility, walking through hallways and in dressing room while preparing for on ice session.

Once players and coaches leaving dressing room to enter on ice area, they are then eligible to remove mask while on playing surface.

All players and coaches will be required to again wear their mask once returning to the dressing room and exiting the facility.

Spectators

All spectators once entered the facility will be required to wear a mask for the entirety of their time inside the facility. Spectators are not required to wear a mask outside the facility, but it is strongly recommended. Protocol social distancing both inside and outside of bubble should be followed.

Facility Capacity

Playing Surface

A maximum of 50 people without social distancing is acceptable. These 50 people are made up of all players and bench staff for both teams, on ice officials and off ice officials.

****No exceptions, some teams maybe required to limit bench staff to adhere to these guidelines****

Spectating Capacity

Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre is able to allow up to 100 spectators at one time as per the Nova Scotia Return to Play and Social gathering guidelines.

**** At this time Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre has made the decision to having the upstairs warm room remain closed to ensure these guidelines are met****

Dressing Rooms

All players and coaches must remain in their dressing room until they are scheduled to go onto the ice. Players and coaches are not allowed to view the on-ice session before them.

Games

During minor hockey games only, players and coaching staff will be allowed in the dressing room area, to ensure we adhere to gathering limits.

Practices

During scheduled minor hockey practices each player will be able to have one parent assist their child in the dressing room. This parent will be required to wear their mask their entire time they are in the building including the dressing rooms.

Facility Rules

Food and Beverage

No **spectators** will be allowed to carry in any outside food or beverage into the facility.

Water Bottles

All **players** who wish to use a water bottle while in the facility will be required to bring their own bottle and have the bottles labeled. Sharing of water bottles will not be allowed. All bottles will be required to be removed from the facility when you leave.

Washrooms

All public washrooms inside the facility will be limited to a maximum of two (2) users at any single time. If entering a washroom that is already at max capacity, it will be up to the user to return to the hallway and wait until someone else leaves.

Contact Tracing

The renter/home team of each ice session will be responsible for record keeping for contact tracing purposes. Records are required to be kept for twenty-one (21) days following the scheduled ice time.

It is also the responsibility of the renter/home team to ensure all COVID19 and Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre protocols are being followed during said scheduled ice times. This duty includes but is not limited to the following actions:

- Ensuring facility capacity is not over maximum numbers
- All on ice participants and spectators are adhering to proper limitations and COVID19 social distancing protocols
- Contact tracing information of all on ice participants and spectators are being kept
- Adhere to all protocols in the reopening plan October 2020

Cleaning Protocols

Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre will follow strict cleaning protocols as suggested by the Nova Scotia Government. These protocols will include an increase in the cleaning of frequently touched surfaces, provide additional hand sanitization stations as well as increase in safety signage and protocols.

RENTAL AGREEMENT – TOWN OF TRENTON

This is to be signed and submitted to the Trenton Minor Sports Community Centre prior to any facility bookings being confirmed. Renter is responsible for record keeping of who is in the facility during bookings.
