**HL: Waste, recycling and compost collection services continue to be offered in Pictou County**

Pictou County Solid Waste has introduced some changes in the way it does business because of the COVID-19 crisis, but curbside collection will continue as usual.

Sasha Barnard, regional educator of Pictou County Solid Waste, said the Pictou County site remains open Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., but residents are asked to keep from visiting the site unless it is absolutely necessary.

“Pictou County Solid Waste Management is making significant operational changes to limit contact between staff and the public in order to keep our community safe. If you must come to our site, we ask that you pay with debit or credit until further notice, where possible,” she said.

There is no change to curbside collection in Pictou County, but residents are reminded for the health and safety of curbside waste collectors that loose items, torn bags or bags that are not tied and closed properly will not be collected until further notice.

Residents can continue to use the Pictou County Solid Waste recently revamped website and free app to keep up to date on any changes that might occur at the site.

It is as easy as typing on its website, [www.pcwastemgmt.com/](http://www.pcwastemgmt.com/) and putting in your home address. If you have a mobile phone, you can also download its free app in either Google Play or the Apple App Store.

“We thank residents for their patience and understanding in these difficult times and will endeavour to keep residents of the Pictou County informed of any operational changes as necessary,” she said.
